What is the Eventers' Training Competition?

At these Winter events, riders get the chance to compete their horses or ponies over the three eventing disciplines, Dressage, Show Jumping and Cross Country. Each combination first rides a dressage test, and after 30 minutes or so moves into the Petplan Equine All-Weather Arena. In this arena, riders first compete over a show jumping course of some 12 or so fences. They then move straight onto the Cross Country phase, jumping a further 14 or so eventing style jumps without leaving the arena. These days are becoming increasingly popular with event riders bringing on younger horses as well as those wishing to try eventing for the first time.
