What is the Eventers' Training Competition?

At these events, riders get the chance to compete their horses or ponies over the three eventing disciplines, Dressage, Show Jumping and Cross Country. Each combination first rides a dressage test, and after 30 minutes or so moves into the All-Weather Arena. In this arena, riders first compete over a show jumping course of some 12 or so fences. They then move

straight onto the Cross Country phase, jumping a further 14 or so eventing style jumps without leaving the arena. These events are becoming increasingly popular with event riders bringing on younger horses as well as those wishing to try eventing for the first time. Full schedules, entry forms as well as images of the cross-country jumps can be found on www.cricklands.com. Entries must be made at least 1 week in advance of this event.

Arena Hunter Trial

Pre-Entry Required as Times Allocated

Only at Cricklands!

Entry: £12.50

The course is laid and out walked by the riders. There will be up to approximately 18 fences, which will all be jumped in one go. Part of the course will be timed, usually the middle section with approximately 6 fences. This will be clearly marked. The winner of the class will be the rider that completes the course in the fastest time. Each error will lead to a time penalty. **TEAM RELAY CHASE** is based on this event. Classes (1) 2'2", (2) 2'6", (3) 2'10", (4) 3'2", (5) 3'6"

Fence Down: 4 Seconds
 Refusal: 4 Seconds (2 Refusals lead to Elimination)
 Rider Fall: Elimination
 Dismounting at the gate: 20 Second Time Penalty
 Max Time: 3 minutes, 30 seconds. Any longer than this will lead to Elimination. For more information on the rules, please speak to the staff on the day, or contact the show office.
