## Eventers' Training Competitions

The 3 Phases Dressage= £8, Jumping and Cross Country Round= £15  
**Package Price: (Dressage, Jumping and Cross Country)= £20**

(a) **Dressage** All tests will be carried out on all weather surfaces. The rider will receive 100 marks *less* the percentage scored. So for instance, if someone scores 120 points out of 150, that would be 80%, and so would receive 20 marks. Whips and callers are permitted. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.

(b) **Show Jumping** (Sections (b) and (c) will be carried out in the All-Weather Arena consecutively). Knock down = 4 faults, refusal = 4 faults, 2nd refusal = elimination, fall of rider or horse = elimination.

(c) **Cross Country** All fences will knock down (images below). Knock down = 4 faults, refusal = 20 faults, 3rd refusal = elimination, fall of rider or horse = elimination. Each competitor will have an allotted time of 4 minutes to complete the jumping phases.

### Class 100 Introductory Class

- (a) **BE 90 Dressage Test 91 (2009)**
- (b) Up to 10 fences, not exceeding 2'2" (65cms)
- (c) Up to 12 fences, not exceeding 2'2" (65cms)

### Class 101 Novice Class

- (a) **BE 90 Dressage Test 91 (2009)**
- (b) Up to 10 fences, not exceeding 2'6" (75cms)
- (c) Up to 12 fences, not exceeding 2'6" (75cms)

### Class 102 Elementary Class

- (a) **BE 90 Dressage Test 91 (2009)**
- (b) Up to 10 fences, not exceeding 2'10" (85cms)
- (c) Up to 12 fences, not exceeding 2'10" (85cms)

### Class 103 Medium Class

- (a) **BE 100 Dressage Test 101 (2009)**
- (b) Up to 10 fences, not exceeding 3'2" (95cms)
- (c) Up to 12 fences, not exceeding 3'2" (95cms)

### Class 104 Advanced Class

- (a) **BE 100 Dressage Test 101 (2009)**
- (b) Up to 10 fences, not exceeding 3'6" (1.05m)
- (c) Up to 12 fences, not exceeding 3'6" (1.05m)



We will allocate a Dressage and Jumping time to each competitor. Times will be available on [www.cricklands.com](http://www.cricklands.com) up to 3 days before the show. In the Jumping and Cross Country sections the course will remain the same with the height increased for each class. The course will need to be walked before the start of the class as there may not be an opportunity once the class has begun. This can be done before any class. Please remember this when checking your competition times. Show times are calculated so that all competitors compete in daylight hours.
